Some of the interesting Legal Language used worldwide are enumerated hereunder:—

LEGAL WORDS / SENTENCES	MEANING
Jane Doe	A fictitious name used for a possible female defendant who is unknown at the time a complaint is filed to start a lawsuit. In addition to the above it is also used as a temporary fictitious name given to an unidentified hospitalized or dead woman.
Case of first impression	A case in which a question of interpretation of law is presented which has never arisen before in any reported case. Sometimes, it is only of first impression in the particular state or jurisdiction, so decisions from other states or the federal courts may be examined as a guideline.
Kangaroo court	A mock/ <i>de-facto</i> court set up without legal basis, such as a fraternity, sports team or army squad might set up to punish minor violations of organizational decorum. The said word is also used as a slang for a court of law in which the violations of procedure, precedents, and due process are so gross that fundamental justice is denied. It usually means that the judge is not competent or obviously biased.

Awareness and Knowledge regarding basic Legal Language, promotes better appreciation and understanding of the Law besides improving Court skills. It also enhances Legal IQ of a person, to face all kinds of competitive exams in general and interviews in particular.
